Mr. STUDDS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts from the contingent fund of the House for expenses of investigations and studies by the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries in the first session of the One Hundred Third Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That for expenses of investigations and
2 studies by the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fish-
3 eries (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the
4 “Committee”), there shall be paid out of the contingent
5 fund of the House not more than \$2,500,441.

6 SEC. 2. Payments under this resolution shall be made
7 on vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the

1 Chairman of the Committee, and approved by the Commit-
2 tee on House Administration.

3 SEC. 3. Amounts shall be available under this resolu-
4 tion for investigations and studies carried out during the
5 period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and ending
6 immediately before noon on January 3, 1994.

7 SEC. 4. Amounts made available under this resolution
8 shall be expended in accordance with regulations pre-
9 scribed by the Committee on House Administration.
