Mr. DE LA GARZA submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

## RESOLUTION

Providing amounts from the contingent fund of the House for expenses of investigations and studies by the Committee on Agriculture in the first session of the One Hundred Third Congress.

1       *Resolved*, That (a) for expenses of investigations and  
2 studies by the Committee on Agriculture (hereinafter in  
3 this resolution referred to as the “Committee”), including  
4 expenses for—

5           (1) procurement of consultant services under  
6 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act  
7 of 1946; and

1           (2) provision of assistance for members of pro-  
2           fessional staff in obtaining specialized training under  
3           section 202(j) of such Act;

4 there shall be paid out of the contingent fund of the House  
5 not more than \$2,341,481.00.

6           (b) Not more than \$10,000.00 of the amount speci-  
7           fied in subsection (a) may be used for consultant services  
8           referred to in paragraph (1) of such subsection and not  
9           more than \$1,000.00 of such amount may be used for spe-  
10          cialized training referred to in paragraph (2) of such sub-  
11          section.

12          SEC. 2. Payments under this resolution shall be made  
13          on vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the  
14          Chairman of the Committee, and approved by the Commit-  
15          tee on House Administration.

16          SEC. 3. Amounts shall be available under this resolu-  
17          tion for investigations and studies carried out during the  
18          period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and ending  
19          immediately before noon on January 3, 1994.

20          SEC. 4. Amounts made available under this resolution  
21          shall be expended in accordance with regulations pre-  
22          scribed by the Committee on House Administration.
