## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Friday, September 29, 1995, it stand ad-  
4 journed until 10 a.m. on Friday, October 6, 1995, or until  
5 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-  
6 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
7 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses  
8 or adjourns on any day beginning with Friday, September  
9 29, 1995, through Friday, October 6, 1995, pursuant to

1 a motion made by the Majority Leader or his designee in  
2 accordance with this resolution, it stand recessed or ad-  
3 journed until noon on Tuesday, October 10, 1995, or until  
4 such time on that day as may be specified by the Majority  
5 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,  
6 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified  
7 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-  
8 olution, whichever occurs first.

9       Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
10 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
11 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
12 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
13 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
14 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
