CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct technical errors in the enrollment of the bill
H.R. 1594.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.
3 1594) to place restrictions on the promotion by the De-
4 partment of Labor and other Federal agencies and instru-
5 mentalities of economically targeted investments in con-
6 nection with employee benefit plans, the Clerk of the
7 House of Representatives shall, in section 5 of the bill,
8 strike “Nothing” and all that follows through the end of
9 such section and insert the following: “Nothing in this Act
10 is intended to affect the ability of the Department of
11 Labor to issue advisory opinions, information letters, tech-

1 nical releases, prohibited transaction exemptions, or other
2 pronouncements interpreting and applying the fiduciary
3 responsibility rules of the Employee Retirement Income
4 Security Act of 1974 in relation to particular factual situ-
5 ations, or exempting specific transactions from the prohib-
6 ited transaction provisions of such Act (pursuant to sec-
7 tions 406 and 408 of such Act (29 U.S.C. 1106, 1108)).”.
