Mr. GALLEGLY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Oversight

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of a report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, prepared by the Congressional Task Force on Immigration Reform.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That there shall be printed as a House docu-
3 ment a report to the Speaker of the House of Representa-
4 tives, prepared by the Congressional Task Force on Immi-
5 gration Reform, dated June 29, 1995. In lieu of the usual
6 number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

7 (1) 2,000 copies of the report, of which a suffi-
8 cient number shall be copies required for the normal
9 distribution of a House document to depository li-

1 braries, 25 copies shall be for the use of the House
2 of Representatives, 25 copies shall be for the use of
3 the Senate, and the remaining copies shall be for the
4 use of the Congressional Task Force on Immigration
5 Reform; or

6 (2) such number of copies as does not exceed
7 a total production and printing cost of \$12,500, with
8 distribution for the use of the House of Representa-
9 tives, the Senate, and the Congressional Task Force
10 on Immigration Reform to be allocated in the same
11 proportion as described in paragraph (1).
