## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the cal-  
3 endar day of Tuesday, January 9, 1996, it stand ad-  
4 journed until 2 p.m. on Monday, January 22, 1996, or  
5 until noon on the second day after Members are notified  
6 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-  
7 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate  
8 recesses or adjourns on the calendar day of Wednesday,  
9 January 10, 1996, pursuant to a motion offered by the  
10 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or ad-  
11 journed until noon on Monday, January 22, 1996, or until  
12 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-

1 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
2 whichever occurs first.

3       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
4 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
5 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
6 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
7 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
8 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
