CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that the Secretary of Agriculture should dispose of all remaining commodities in the disaster reserve maintained under the Agricultural Act of 1970 to relieve the distress of livestock producers whose ability to maintain livestock is adversely affected by disaster conditions existing in certain areas of the United States, such as prolonged drought or flooding.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in light of the prolonged drought and
3 other adverse weather conditions existing in certain areas
4 of the United States, the Secretary of Agriculture should
5 promptly dispose of all commodities in the disaster reserve

1 maintained under section 813 of the Agricultural Act of
2 1970 (7 U.S.C. 1427a) to relieve the distress of livestock
3 producers whose ability to maintain livestock is adversely
4 affected by the disaster conditions, such as prolonged
5 drought or flooding.
