**CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive days of Thursday, June 27, 1996, or Friday, June  
4 28, 1996, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority  
5 Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until noon on  
6 Monday, July 8, 1996, or until noon on the second day  
7 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-  
8 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first;  
9 and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close  
10 of business on Thursday, June 27, 1996, Friday, June  
11 28, 1996, Saturday, June 29, 1996, or Sunday, June 30,  
12 1996, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority Leader  
13 or his designee in accordance with this resolution, it stand  
14 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, July 8,  
15 1996, or until such time on that day as may be specified  
16 by the Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to  
17 recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after  
18 Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section  
19 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

1        SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
2 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
3 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
4 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
5 and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their  
6 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
