## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Secretary of the Senate to make corrections  
in the enrollment of S. 1004.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill S. 1004,  
3 the Secretary of the Senate shall make the following cor-  
4 rections:

5            (1) In section 1106(c), in the text added to sec-  
6        tion 5 of the Act of January 2, 1951—

---

1 (A) strike “This section does not prohibit,  
 2 nor may any State make” and insert in lieu  
 3 thereof “With respect to a vessel operating in  
 4 Alaska, this section does not prohibit, nor may  
 5 the State of Alaska make”;

6 (B) strike “except that a State may” and  
 7 insert in lieu thereof “except that such State  
 8 may”; and

9 (C) strike paragraph (2) and insert in lieu  
 10 thereof the following:

11 “(2) A voyage referred to in paragraph (1) is a voy-  
 12 age that—

13 “(A) includes a stop in Canada or in a State  
 14 other than the State of Alaska;

15 “(B) includes stops in at least 2 different ports  
 16 situated in the State of Alaska; and

17 “(C) is of at least 60 hours duration.”.

18 (2) In section 1113(d), in the text added to sec-  
 19 tion 12106 of title 46, United States Code, in sub-  
 20 section (e)(1)(E) strike “section 12102” and insert  
 21 in lieu thereof “this section”.
