JOINT RESOLUTION

Waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect to any bill or joint resolution of the One Hundred Fourth Congress making general or continuing appropriations for fiscal year 1997.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF REQUIREMENT FOR PARCHMENT**
4 **PRINTING.**

5 (a) WAIVER.—The provisions of sections 106 and
6 107 of title 1, United States Code, are waived with respect
7 to the printing (on parchment or otherwise) of the enroll-
8 ment of any appropriation measure of the One Hundred

1 Fourth Congress presented to the President after the en-
2 actment of this joint resolution.

3 (b) CERTIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT BY COMMIT-
4 TEE ON HOUSE OVERSIGHT.—The enrollment of any such
5 measure shall be in such form as the Committee on House
6 Oversight of the House of Representatives certifies to be
7 a true enrollment.

8 **SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION MEASURE DEFINED.**

9 For purposes of this joint resolution, the term “ap-
10 propriation measure” means a bill or joint resolution that
11 includes provisions making general or continuing appro-
12 priations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997.
