## A BILL

To designate certain lands in Alaska as wilderness.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Morris K. Udall Wil-  
3 derness Act of 1995”.

4 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WILDERNESS AREA.**

5 In furtherance of the provisions of the Wilderness  
6 Act, an area in Alaska comprising approximately  
7 1,559,538 acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled  
8 “Arctic National Wildlife Refuge—1002 Area Alternative  
9 E—Wilderness Designation”, dated October 28, 1991,  
10 and available for inspection in the offices of the Secretary  
11 of the Interior, is hereby designated as wilderness and,  
12 therefore, as a component of the National Wilderness  
13 Preservation System.
