AN ACT

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

2 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
3 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) the Federal En-
4 ergy Regulatory Commission, upon the request of the li-
5 censee for FERC Project No. 9423 (and after reasonable
6 notice), is authorized, in accordance with the good faith,
7 due diligence, and public interest requirements of such
8 section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such
9 section, to extend the time required for commencement of
10 construction for the project for up to a maximum of 3
11 consecutive 2-year periods. This section shall take effect
12 for the project upon the expiration of the extension (issued
13 by the Commission under such section 13) of the period
14 required for commencement of construction of such
15 project.
