## **A BILL**

To terminate the Office of the Surgeon General of the Public Health Service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That all authorities, funds, and personnel of the Office  
4       of the Surgeon General of the Public Health Service are  
5       transferred to the Assistant Secretary for Health of the  
6       Department of Health and Human Services, and such Of-  
7       fice, and the position of such Surgeon General, are termi-  
8       nated.
