A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to issue a certificate of documentation with appropriate endorsement for employment in the coastwise trade and on the Great Lakes and their tributary and connecting waters in trade with Canada for each of two barges.

7 tation may issue a certificate of documentation with ap-

4 barges owned by Roen Salvage (a company incorporated
5 under the laws of the State of Wisconsin and having its
6 principal place of business in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin)
7 and numbered 103 and 203 by Roen Salvage.
