To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to substitute references to children born out of wedlock for references to illegitimate children in the definition of child.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF CHILD.**

4 Section 101(b) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(b)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1)—

7 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “le-
8 gitimate child” and inserting “child born in
9 wedlock”; and

1 (B) in subparagraph (D), by striking “an
2 illegitimate child” and inserting “a child born
3 out of wedlock”; and

4 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “an illegit-
5 imate child” and inserting “a child born out of wed-
6 lock”.
