Mr. BURTON of Indiana introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to specify the use of computers in or affecting commerce as a basis for Federal prosecution of certain obscenity offenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 1465 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) by inserting “or knowingly uses a computer in
6 or affecting interstate or foreign commerce for the pur-
7 poses of sale or distribution of,” after “obscene material
8 in interstate or foreign commerce,”; and

1 (2) by striking “five years” and inserting “10 years”.
