1 **SECTION 1. LAND ACQUISITION AUTHORITY FOR SAN**
2 **BERNARDINO, CLEVELAND, AND ANGELES**
3 **NATIONAL FORESTS, CALIFORNIA.**

4 The Act of June 15, 1938 (Chapter 438; 52 Stat.
5 699), as amended by the Act of May 26, 1944 (58 Stat.
6 227), is further amended—

7 (1) by striking “San Bernardino and Cleve-
8 land” and inserting “San Bernardino, Cleveland,
9 and Angeles”;

10 (2) by striking “county of Riverside” each place
11 it appears and inserting “counties of Riverside and
12 San Bernardino”; and

13 (3) by striking “as to minimize soil erosion and
14 flood damage” and inserting “for National Forest
15 System purposes”.
