A BILL

To repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault weapons and the ban on large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gun Ban Repeal Act
5 of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE BAN ON SEMIAUTOMATIC ASSAULT**
2 **WEAPONS AND THE BAN ON LARGE CAPACITY**
3 **AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United
5 States Code, is amended by striking subsections (v) and
6 (w) and by striking the appendix.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS AND REPEAL.—

8 (1) Section 921(a) of such title is amended by
9 striking paragraph (31).

10 (2) Section 924(a)(1)(B) of such title is amend-
11 ed by striking “(r), (v),”.

12 (3) Section 923(i) of such title is amended by
13 striking the last 2 sentences.

14 (4) Section 110104 of the Violent Crime Con-
15 trol and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 is hereby
16 repealed.
