Mr. MOAKLEY (for himself, Mr. RANGEL, Mrs. KENNELLY, Mrs. MEYERS of Kansas, Ms. PRYCE, and Mr. NEAL of Massachusetts) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide for duty free treatment for entries and withdrawals of tamoxifen citrate after December 31, 1993, and before January 1, 1995.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DUTY FREE TREATMENT OF CERTAIN ENTRIES**
4 **AND WITHDRAWALS.**

5 Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tariff Act of
6 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provision of law, upon
7 a request filed with the Customs Service before the 90th
8 day after the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry
9 or withdrawal from warehouse for consumption of

1 tamoxifen citrate (provided for in subheading 2922.19.10
2 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States,
3 as in effect on December 1, 1994)—

4 (1) which was made after December 31, 1993,
5 and before January 1, 1995, and

6 (2) with respect to which there would have been
7 no duty if such entry or withdrawal had been made
8 on or after January 1, 1995,
9 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such entry
10 or withdrawal had been made on or after January 1, 1995.
