Mr. MONTGOMERY (by request) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of John T. Monk.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIEF FROM FURTHER PREMIUM PAYMENTS**

4 **UNDER NSLI PROGRAM.**

5 (a) TERMINATION OF PREMIUM PAYMENTS.—(1)

6 Notwithstanding any provision of subchapter I of chapter
7 19 of title 38, United States Code, John T. Monk of Jack-
8 son, Mississippi, may not be required to make premium
9 payments after the date of the enactment of this Act for
10 the National Service Life Insurance insurance policy for
11 which such individual was making monthly premium pay-
12 ments before such date.

1 (2) The termination of the requirement for premium
2 payments under paragraph (1) shall not terminate or oth-
3 erwise affect the coverage of John T. Monk of Jackson,
4 Mississippi, under the insurance policy referred to in such
5 paragraph.

6 (b) REFUND OF AMOUNT PREVIOUSLY PAID IN EX-
7 CESS OF INSURANCE AMOUNT.—The Secretary of the
8 Treasury shall pay, out of any sums in the Treasury not
9 otherwise appropriated, to John T. Monk of Jackson, Mis-
10 sissippi, the amount equal to the difference between—

11 (1) the aggregate amount of the monthly pre-
12 mium payments by John T. Monk of Jackson, Mis-
13 sissippi, for the National Service Life Insurance in-
14 surance policy referred to in subsection (a)(1) be-
15 tween the date of the commencement of monthly
16 premium payments by that individual for that insur-
17 ance policy and the date of the enactment of this
18 Act; and

19 (2) the amount of insurance under that insur-
20 ance policy.
