## AN ACT

For the relief of Kris Murty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. RELOCATION EXPENSES FOR KRIS MURTY.**

2 For the purpose of receiving reimbursement for relo-  
3 cation expenses under sections 5724 and 5724a of title  
4 5, United States Code, Kris Murty of El Paso, Texas, an  
5 employee of the Department of the Army, is deemed to  
6 have been an employee transferred by the Department of  
7 the Army from one official station to another for perma-  
8 nent duty when he relocated from Houston, Texas, to Fort  
9 Bliss, Texas, in February 1985.

10 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

11 No amount exceeding 10 percent of a payment made  
12 pursuant to section 1 may be paid to or received by any  
13 agent or attorney in consideration for services rendered  
14 in connection with the payment. Any person who violates  
15 the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an infrac-  
16 tion and shall be subject to a fine in the amount provided  
17 under title 18, United States Code.
