To change election day to the first Saturday in November of each even-numbered year.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHANGE IN CONGRESSIONAL ELECTION DAY**

4 **TO SATURDAY.**

5 Section 25 of the Revised Statutes of the United
6 States (2 U.S.C. 7) is amended by striking out “Tuesday
7 next after the first Monday” the second place it appears
8 and inserting in lieu thereof “first Saturday”.

1 **SEC. 2. CHANGE IN PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION DAY TO SAT-**
2 **URDAY.**

3 Section 1 of title 3, United States Code, is amended
4 by striking out “Tuesday next after the first Monday” and
5 inserting in lieu thereof “first Saturday”.
