A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to carry out an environmental restoration project at the Eastern Channel of the Lockwoods Folly River, Brunswick County, North Carolina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LOCKWOODS FOLLY RIVER, BRUNSWICK COUN-**
4 **TY, NORTH CAROLINA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army shall
6 carry out a project under section 1135 of the Water Re-
7 sources Development Act of 1986 (100 Stat. 4251–4252;
8 33 U.S.C. 2309a) at the Eastern Channel of the

1 Lockwoods Folly River, Brunswick County, North Caro-
2 lina.

3 (b) PROJECT FEATURES.—In carrying out the
4 project under subsection (a), the Secretary shall open the
5 Old Eastern Navigation Channel at the mouth of the
6 Lockwoods Folly River in Brunswick County, North Caro-
7 lina, and partially close the present ocean channel between
8 the west end of Sheep Island and the northeast point of
9 Holden Beach.

10 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
11 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
12 \$5,000,000 for fiscal years beginning after September 30,
13 1995. Such sums shall remain available until expended.
