Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight

A BILL

To amend title 39, United States Code, to require the Postal Service to accept a change-of-address order from a commercial mail receiving agency and to forward mail to the new address.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHANGE-OF-ADDRESS ORDER BY COMMERCIAL**
4 **MAIL RECEIVING AGENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 36 of title 39, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
7 ing:

1 **“§ 3686. Change-of-address order by commercial mail**
2 **receiving agency**

3 “Upon termination of an agency relationship between
4 an addressee and a commercial mail receiving agency, ei-
5 ther the addressee or the commercial mail receiving agency
6 may file a change-of-address order with the Postal Service.
7 The Postal Service shall forward to such addressee mail
8 which is marked for forwarding by the commercial mail
9 receiving agency in the same manner as, and subject to
10 the same terms and conditions as apply to, mail forwarded
11 directly by the Postal Service to such addressee.”.

12 (b) TABLE OF CONTENTS.—The table of contents at
13 the beginning of chapter 36 of title 39, United States
14 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
15 section 3685 the following new item:

“3686. Change-of-address order by commercial mail receiving agency.”.
