AN ACT

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that the Inspector General of the Office of Personnel Management may use amounts in the revolving fund of the Office to fund audits, investigations, and oversight activities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “OPM IG Act”.

3 **SEC. 2. USE OF OFFICE OF PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT RE-**
4 **VOLVING FUND FOR AUDITS, INVESTIGA-**
5 **TIONS, AND OVERSIGHT ACTIVITIES.**

6 Subsection (e) of section 1304 of title 5, United
7 States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by adding before the pe-
9 riod at the end of the first sentence the following:
10 “, and for the cost of audits, investigations, and
11 oversight activities, conducted by the Inspector Gen-
12 eral of the Office, of the fund and the activities fi-
13 nanced by the fund”; and

14 (2) in paragraph (5)—

15 (A) by striking “The Office” and inserting
16 “(A) The Office”; and

17 (B) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(B) Such budget shall include an estimate
19 from the Inspector General of the Office of the
20 amount required to pay the expenses to audit, inves-
21 tigate, and provide other oversight activities with re-
22 spect to the fund and the activities financed by the
23 fund.

24 “(C) The amount requested by the Inspector
25 General under subparagraph (B) shall not exceed

1 .33 percent of the total budgetary authority re-
2 quested by the Office under subparagraph (A).”.
