To require the Consumer Product Safety Commission to
ban toys which in size, shape, or overall appearance
resemble real handguns.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TOY HANDGUNS.**

4 The Consumer Product Safety Commission shall pro-
5 mulgate a rule in accordance with section 9 of the
6 Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2058) to declare
7 as a banned hazardous product under section 8 any toy
8 which in size, shape, or overall appearance resembles a
9 real handgun.
