A BILL

To permit certain revenues of the District of Columbia to be expended for activities relating to the operation of the Washington Convention Center and the construction of a new convention center in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Convention Center Preconstruction Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMITTING DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA TO EXPEND**
2 **REVENUES FOR CONVENTION CENTER AC-**
3 **TIVITIES.**

4 (a) PERMITTING EXPENDITURE WITHOUT APPRO-
5 PRIATION.—The fourth sentence of section 446 of the Dis-
6 trict of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Re-
7 organization Act (sec. 47–304, D.C. Code) shall not apply
8 with respect to any revenues of the District of Columbia
9 which are attributable to the enactment of title III of the
10 Washington Convention Center Authority Act of 1994
11 (D.C. Law 10–188) and which are obligated or expended
12 for the activities described in subsection (b).

13 (b) ACTIVITIES DESCRIBED.—The activities de-
14 scribed in this paragraph are—

15 (1) the operation and maintenance of the exist-
16 ing Washington Convention Center; and

17 (2) pre-construction activities with respect to a
18 new convention center in the District of Columbia,
19 including land acquisition and the conducting of en-
20 vironmental impact studies, architecture and design
21 studies, surveys, and site acquisition.

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
