Mr. DUNCAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Gregory E. Walters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM AGAINST UNITED**
4 **STATES.**

5 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
6 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
7 sum of \$225,000 to Gregory E. Walters of Knoxville, Ten-
8 nessee. The payment shall be in full satisfaction of any
9 claim Gregory E. Walters may have against the United
10 States arising out of any allegation made by him against
11 the Tennessee Valley Authority, with respect to the admin-
12 istration of any program for the insulation of houses, while

1 employed with the Tennessee Valley Authority from 1977
2 to 1980.

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEYS AND AGENTS FEES.**

4 It shall be unlawful for more than 10 percent of the
5 sum appropriated in section 1 to be paid to or received
6 by any agent or attorney for services rendered in connec-
7 tion with the claim described in such section. Any person
8 who violates this section shall be fined under title 18,
9 United States Code.
