7 Burn Pit Superfund Site, North Carolina, from the Na-

1 tional Priorities List under the Comprehensive Environ-
2 mental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of
3 1980 and, after the date of the enactment of this Act,
4 may not include such Site on such List again.
