A BILL

To limit congressional travel to North Korea.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON CONGRESSIONAL TRAVEL TO**
4 **NORTH KOREA.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, funds
6 appropriated or otherwise made available under section
7 502(b) of the Mutual Security Act of 1954 (22 U.S.C.
8 1754(b)) shall not be available for travel to North Korea
9 unless the President submits to the Congress a certifi-
10 cation that North Korea does not have a policy of discrimi-
11 nating, on the basis of national origin or political philoso-

- 1 phy, against Members and employees of the Congress in
- 2 permitting travel to North Korea.
