Mr. CREMEANS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

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## A BILL

To release restrictions imposed on the use of certain real property conveyed by the Secretary of the Interior to Lawrence County, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST RE-**  
4 **GARDING USE OF PREVIOUSLY CONVEYED**  
5 **PROPERTY IN LAWRENCE COUNTY, OHIO.**

6 (a) RELEASE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the Inte-  
7 rior shall release, without consideration, the reversionary  
8 interest of the United States in the real property described  
9 in subsection (b).

1 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The real property referred to in  
2 subsection (a) is a parcel of real property consisting of  
3 approximately 15.41 acres located in Fayette Township,  
4 Lawrence County, Ohio, which was originally conveyed by  
5 the Secretary of the Interior to the Board of Lawrence  
6 County Commissioners pursuant to section 203(k)(2) of  
7 the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of  
8 1949 (40 U.S.C. 484(k)(2)).

9 (c) INSTRUMENT OF RELEASE.—The Secretary shall  
10 execute and file in the appropriate office or offices a deed  
11 of release, amended deed, or other appropriate instrument  
12 effectuating the release of the reversionary interest under  
13 this section.

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
