## AN ACT

To designate the Federal building located at 1550 Dewey Avenue, Baker City, Oregon, as the “David J. Wheeler Federal Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2       The Federal building located at 1550 Dewey Avenue,  
3 Baker City, Oregon, shall be known and designated as the  
4 “David J. Wheeler Federal Building”.

5 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

6       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
7 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal  
8 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
9 a reference to the “David J. Wheeler Federal Building”.
