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## A BILL

To amend the National School Lunch Act to provide greater flexibility to schools to meet the Dietary Guidelines for Americans under the school lunch and school breakfast programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED FLEXIBILITY FOR SCHOOLS TO**  
4 **MEET THE DIETARY GUIDELINES FOR AMERI-**  
5 **CANS UNDER THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH**  
6 **ACT.**

7 Section 9(f)(2)(D) of the National School Lunch Act  
8 (42 U.S.C. 1758(f)(2)(D)) is amended to read as follows:

1       “(D) Schools may use any reasonable approach to  
2 meet the requirements of this paragraph, including any  
3 of the approaches described in subparagraph (C). The Sec-  
4 retary may not require the schools to conduct or use nutri-  
5 ent analysis.”.
