## AN ACT

To provide for the distribution within the United States of the United States Information Agency film entitled “Fragile Ring of Life”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DISTRIBUTION WITHIN THE UNITED STATES OF**  
2 **UNITED STATES INFORMATION AGENCY FILM**  
3 **ENTITLED “FRAGILE RING OF LIFE”.**

4 Notwithstanding section 208 of the Foreign Relations  
5 Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1986 and 1987 (22  
6 U.S.C. 1461–1(a)) and the second sentence of section 501  
7 of the United States Information and Education Exchange  
8 Act of 1948 (22 U.S.C. 1461)—

9 (1) the Director of the United States Informa-  
10 tion Agency shall make available to the Archivist of  
11 the United States a master copy of the film entitled  
12 “Fragile Ring of Life”; and

13 (2) upon evidence that necessary United States  
14 rights and licenses have been secured and paid for  
15 by the person seeking domestic release of the film,  
16 the Archivist shall—

17 (A) reimburse the Director for any ex-  
18 penses of the Agency in making that master  
19 copy available;

20 (B) deposit that film in the National Ar-  
21 chives of the United States; and

22 (C) make copies of that film available for  
23 purchase and public viewing within the United  
24 States.

1 Any reimbursement to the Director pursuant to this sec-  
2 tion shall be credited to the applicable appropriation of  
3 the United States Information Agency.
