Mrs. THURMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Robert L. Quinn.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
6 Robert L. Quinn of Spring Hill, Florida, the sum of
7 \$1,998. The payment shall be in full satisfaction of all
8 unsettled claims against the United States for reimburse-
9 ment for civil service annuity benefits that he was required
10 to repay due to an error of the Office of Personnel Man-
11 agement that resulted in an overpayment of his benefits

1 during the period beginning August 1, 1986, and ending
2 May 31, 1987.

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

4 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
5 percent of the sum described in section 1 to be paid to
6 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-
7 dered in connection with the benefits provided by this Act.
8 Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an
9 infraction and shall be subject to a fine in the amount
10 provided in title 18, United States Code.
