## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to maps relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CORRECTIONS TO MAPS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior  
5 shall, before the end of the 30-day period beginning on  
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, make such correc-  
7 tions to the maps described in subsection (b) as are nec-  
8 essary to ensure that depictions of areas on those maps  
9 are consistent with the depictions of areas appearing on

1 the maps entitled \_\_\_\_\_, dated  
2 \_\_\_\_\_, and on file with the Secretary.

3 (b) MAPS DESCRIBED.—The maps described in this  
4 subsection are maps that—

5 (1) are included in a set of maps entitled  
6 “Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated October  
7 24, 1990; and

8 (2) relate to the following units of the Coastal  
9 Barrier Resources System: P04A, P05, P05A, P08,  
10 P10, P11, P11A, P18, P25, FL-90.
