Ms. MICHELLE LUJAN GRISHAM of New Mexico (for herself, Mr. BEN RAY LUJÁN of New Mexico, and Mr. PEARCE) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To make a technical amendment to the T'uf Shur Bien Preservation Trust Area Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sandia Pueblo Settle-
5 ment Technical Amendment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SANDIA PUEBLO SETTLEMENT TECHNICAL AMEND-**
7 **MENT.**

8 Section 413(b) of the T'uf Shur Bien Preservation
9 Trust Area Act (16 U.S.C. 539m–11(b)) is amended—

1 (1) in the first sentence of paragraph (4), by
2 striking “conveyance” and inserting “title to be con-
3 veyed”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(6) FAILURE TO EXCHANGE.—

6 “(A) IN GENERAL.—If the land exchange
7 authorized under paragraph (1) is not com-
8 pleted by the date that is 30 days after the date
9 of enactment of this paragraph, the Secretary,
10 on request of the Pueblo and the Secretary of
11 the Interior, shall transfer the National Forest
12 land generally depicted as ‘Land to be Held in
13 Trust’ on the map entitled ‘Sandia Pueblo Set-
14 tlement Technical Amendment Act’ and dated
15 October 18, 2013, to the Secretary of the Inte-
16 rior to be held in trust by the United States for
17 the Pueblo—

18 “(i) subject to the restriction enforced
19 by the Secretary of the Interior that the
20 land remain undeveloped, with the natural
21 characteristics of the land to be preserved
22 in perpetuity; and

23 “(ii) consistent with subsection (c).

24 “(B) OTHER TRANSFERS.—After the
25 transfer under subparagraph (A) is complete,

1 the Secretary of the Interior, with the consent
2 of the Pueblo, shall—

3 “(i) transfer to the Secretary, con-
4 sistent with section 411(c)—

5 “(I) the La Luz tract generally
6 depicted on the map entitled ‘Sandia
7 Pueblo Settlement Technical Amend-
8 ment Act’ and dated October 18,
9 2013; and

10 “(II) the conservation easement
11 for the Piedra Lisa tract generally de-
12 picted on the map entitled ‘Sandia
13 Pueblo Settlement Technical Amend-
14 ment Act’ and dated October 18,
15 2013; and

16 “(ii) grant to the Secretary a right-of-
17 way for the Piedra Lisa Trail within the
18 Piedra Lisa tract generally depicted on the
19 map entitled ‘Sandia Pueblo Settlement
20 Technical Amendment Act’ and dated Oc-
21 tober 18, 2013.”.
