## A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF LOCAL RAIL FREIGHT AS-**  
4 **SISTANCE PROGRAM.**

5 Part B of subtitle V of title 49, United States Code,  
6 and the items relating thereto in the table of chapters of  
7 such subtitle, are repealed.
