## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to regulate the manufacture, importation, and sale of polymer plastic ammunition.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement Offi-  
5 cials Protection Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF ARMOR PIERCING AMMUNITION EX-**  
2 **PANDED TO INCLUDE POLYMER PLASTIC AM-**  
3 **MUNITION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 921(a)(17)(B) of title 18,  
5 United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (i);

7 and

8 (2) by redesignating clause (ii) as clause (iii)

9 and inserting after clause (i) the following:

10 “(ii) a projectile or projectile core which may be  
11 used in a firearm and which is constructed entirely  
12 (excluding the presence of traces of other sub-  
13 stances) from polymer plastic; or”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
15 subsection (a) shall apply to conduct engaged in after the  
16 30-day period that begins with the date of the enactment  
17 of this Act.
