A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into agreements for the use of facilities associated with the Solano Project, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF THE WARREN ACT.**

4 (a) AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 may—

6 (1) enter into contracts with private entities
7 pursuant to the Act of February 21, 1911 (com-
8 monly known as the “Warren Act”) (36 Stat. 925
9 et seq., chapter 141; 43 U.S.C. 523 et seq.), for the

1 impounding, storage, and carriage of nonproject
2 water for domestic, municipal, fish and wildlife, in-
3 dustrial, and other beneficial purposes, using any fa-
4 cilities associated with the Solano Project, Califor-
5 nia; and

6 (2) enter into agreements, under terms and
7 conditions authorized for contracts under such Act,
8 with appropriate officials of other Federal agencies,
9 municipalities, public water districts and agencies,
10 and the State of California for impounding, storage,
11 and carriage of nonproject water for purposes de-
12 scribed in paragraph (1) using facilities referred to
13 in such paragraph.

14 (b) NONPROJECT WATER DEFINED.—In subsection
15 (a), the term “nonproject water” means water that is not
16 from a Federal reclamation project.
