1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELECTRICAL CAPACITORS.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

9902.85.32	Power capacitors (pro- vided for in sub- heading 8532.10.00), aluminum electrolytic (provided for in sub- heading 8532.22.00), and dielectric of paper or plastics (provided for in subheading 8532.25.00), fixed electrical capacitors ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/97	..

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2       The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with  
3 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
