A BILL

To improve the capability to analyze deoxyribonucleic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DNA Identification
5 Grants Improvement Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. DNA IDENTIFICATION GRANTS.**

2 Paragraph ~~(22)~~ of section 1001(a) of the Omnibus
3 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 ~~“(22) There are authorized to be appropriated~~
6 ~~to carry out part X—~~

7 ~~“(A) \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 1996;~~

8 ~~“(B) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 1997;~~

9 ~~“(C) \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;~~

10 ~~“(D) \$6,000,000 for fiscal year 1999; and~~

11 ~~“(E) \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 2000.”.~~

12 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

13 *This Act may be cited as the “DNA Identification*
14 *Grants Improvement Act of 1995”.*

15 **SEC. 2. DNA IDENTIFICATION GRANTS.**

16 *Paragraph (22) of section 1001(a) of the Omnibus*
17 *Crime Control and Safe Streets Act is amended to read as*
18 *follows:*

19 *“(22) There are authorized to be appropriated to carry*
20 *out part X—*

21 *“(A) \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 1996;*

22 *“(B) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 1997;*

23 *“(C) \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;*

24 *“(D) \$6,000,000 for fiscal year 1999; and*

25 *“(E) \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 2000.”.*

1 **SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON GRANT USE.**

2 *Section 210304 of the Violent Crime Control and Law*
3 *Enforcement Act of 1994 is amended by adding at the end*
4 *the following:*

5 *“(d) DNA PROFILES PROHIBITED.—In no event shall*
6 *DNA identification records contained in this index be com-*
7 *piled or analyzed in order to formulate statistical profiles*
8 *for use in predicting criminal behavior.”.*

9 **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.**

10 *Effective on the date of the enactment of the Violent*
11 *Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, section*
12 *210302(c)(3) of such Act is amended by inserting “(a)”*
13 *after “Section 1001” and after “3793”.*
