Mr. ROSE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee
on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of James M. Hughs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENTITLEMENT TO TREATMENT AS UNITED**
4 **STATES ARMY CAPTAIN.**

5 For all purposes, James M. Hughs of Fayetteville,
6 North Carolina, shall be treated as having retired from
7 the United States Army as a captain (grade 0-3).

8 **SEC. 2. ENTITLEMENT TO BACK PAY.**

9 The Secretary of the Army shall pay a lump sum to
10 James M. Hughs, which shall be the difference between
11 the amount that should have been paid to him if he were
12 a captain and the amount actually paid to him, for the

1 period beginning on May 31, 1971, and ending on the last
2 day of the month in which this Act is enacted.
