3 **“SEC. 11. ADDITIONAL GOSHUTE INDIAN RESERVATION**
4 **LANDS.**

5 “(a) FURTHER ADDITIONS TO GOSHUTE RESERVA-
6 TION.—In addition to the lands described in section 3, for
7 the purpose of securing in trust for the Goshute Indian
8 Tribe certain additional public lands and lands belonging
9 to the State of Utah, which comprise approximately 8,000
10 acres of surface and subsurface estate, as generally de-
11 picted on the map entitled ‘Additional Utah-Goshute Ex-
12 change’, dated July 1, 1994, such public lands and State
13 lands are hereby declared to be part of the Goshute Indian
14 Reservation in the State of Utah effective upon the com-
15 pletion of conveyance of the State lands from the State
16 of Utah and acceptance of title by the United States.

17 “(b) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior
18 is authorized to acquire through exchange those lands and
19 interests in land described in subsection (a) which are
20 owned by the State of Utah, subject to valid existing
21 rights.

22 “(c) APPLICATION OF PRIOR PROVISIONS.—(1) Ex-
23 cept as provided in paragraph (2), the remaining provi-
24 sions of this Act which are applicable to the lands to be

1 transferred to the Goshute Indian Tribe pursuant to sec-
2 tion 3 shall also apply to the lands subject to this section.

3 “(2) The Goshute Indian Tribe will be responsible for
4 payment of the costs of appraisal of the lands to be ac-
5 quired pursuant to this section, which costs shall be paid
6 prior to the transfer of such lands.”.
