3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Wanda Boughton So-
5 cial Security Original Intent Act of 1995".

1 **SEC. 2. RECEIPT OF BOTH OLD-AGE OR DISABILITY INSUR-**
2 **ANCE BENEFITS AND WIDOW'S OR WIDOW-**
3 **ER'S INSURANCE BENEFITS WITHOUT REDUC-**
4 **TION IN THE WIDOW'S OR WIDOWER'S INSUR-**
5 **ANCE BENEFIT.**

6 Section 202(k)(3)(A) of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 402(k)(3)(A)) is amended by inserting “(other
8 than a widow’s or widower’s insurance benefit)” after
9 “any other monthly insurance benefit for such month”.

10 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 The amendment made by section 2 of this Act shall
12 apply with respect to benefits for months after the date
13 of the enactment of this Act.
