AN ACT

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a penalty for knowingly selling advertising that offers certain commercial sex acts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Advertising Vic-
3 tims of Exploitation Act of 2014” or the “SAVE Act of
4 2014”.

5 **SEC. 2. ADVERTISING THAT OFFERS CERTAIN COMMERCIAL SEX ACTS.**

7 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1591 of title 18, United
8 States Code, is amended in subsection (a)(1), by inserting
9 after “obtains,” the following: “advertises,”.

10 (b) **MENS REA REQUIREMENT.**—Section 1591 of title
11 18, United States Code, is amended in subsection (a), by
12 inserting after “knowing, or” the following: “, except
13 where, in an offense under paragraph (2), the act consti-
14 tuting the violation of paragraph (1) is advertising,”.

15 (c) **CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**—Section 1591(b)
16 of title 18, United States Code, is amended—

17 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “or obtained”
18 and inserting “obtained, or advertised”; and

19 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “or obtained”
20 and inserting “obtained, or advertised”.
