A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a penalty for knowingly selling advertising that offers certain commercial sex acts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Advertising Vic-
5 tims of Exploitation Act of 2014” or the “SAVE Act of
6 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADVERTISING THAT OFFERS CERTAIN COMMER-**
2 **CIAL SEX ACTS.**

3 **“§ 1591A. Advertising that offers certain commercial**
4 **sex acts**

5 “(a) OFFENSE.—Whoever, in or affecting interstate
6 or foreign commerce, knowingly benefits financially from,
7 receives anything of value from, or distributes advertising
8 that offers a commercial sex act in a manner prohibited
9 under section 1591, shall be fined under this title, impris-
10 oned not more than 5 years, or both.

11 “(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms have
12 the meanings given those terms in section 1591.”.

13 **SEC. 3. EXTRA-TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.**

14 Section 1596 of title 18, United States Code, is
15 amended by striking “or 1591” and inserting “1591, or
16 1591A”.

17 **SEC. 4. CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**

18 The table of sections at the beginning of chapter 77
19 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by inserting
20 after the item relating to section 1591 the following:

“1591A. Advertising that offers certain commercial sex acts.”.

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
