Mrs. COLLINS of Illinois introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide for the reliquidation of certain entries of imported chemicals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
5 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
6 vision of law, upon proper request filed with the United
7 States Customs Service within 180 days after the date of
8 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury
9 shall—

10 (1) reliquidate, at the rate of duty of 3.7 per-
11 cent ad valorem, the entries described in subsection

1 (b) with respect to the product designated
 2 “Perkadox 16” and all variations thereof under sub-
 3 heading 2920.90.50 of the Harmonized Tariff
 4 Schedule of the United States; and

5 (2) refund any excess duties that were paid
 6 with respect to such entries.

7 (b) AFFECTED ENTRIES.—The entries referred to in
 8 subsection (a) are as follows:
