## A BILL

To make clerical and technical amendments to title 18, United States Code, and other provisions of law relating to crime and criminal justice.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Criminal Law Tech-  
5 nical Amendments Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. GENERAL TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.**

2 (a) FURTHER CORRECTIONS TO MISLEADING FINE  
3 AMOUNTS AND RELATED TYPOGRAPHICAL ERRORS.—

4 (1) Sections 152, 153, 154, and 610 of title 18,  
5 United States Code, are each amended by striking  
6 “fined not more than \$5,000” and inserting “fined  
7 under this title”.

8 (2) Section 970(b) of title 18, United States
