Mr. ROGERS of Michigan introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Select Committee on Intelligence (Permanent Select)

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2014 and 2015 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Intelligence Authoriza-
5 tion Act for Fiscal Years 2014 and 2015”.

1 **TITLE I—INTELLIGENCE**
2 **ACTIVITIES**

3 **SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
5 fiscal years 2014 and 2015 for the conduct of the intel-
6 ligence and intelligence-related activities of the following
7 elements of the United States Government:

8 (1) The Office of the Director of National Intel-
9 ligence.

10 (2) The Central Intelligence Agency.

11 (3) The Department of Defense.

12 (4) The Defense Intelligence Agency.

13 (5) The National Security Agency.

14 (6) The Department of the Army, the Depart-
15 ment of the Navy, and the Department of the Air
16 Force.

17 (7) The Coast Guard.

18 (8) The Department of State.

19 (9) The Department of the Treasury.

20 (10) The Department of Energy.

21 (11) The Department of Justice.

22 (12) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.

23 (13) The Drug Enforcement Administration.

24 (14) The National Reconnaissance Office.

1 (15) The National Geospatial-Intelligence Agen-
2 cy.

3 (16) The Department of Homeland Security.

4 **SEC. 102. CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.**

5 (a) SPECIFICATIONS OF AMOUNTS AND PERSONNEL
6 LEVELS.—

7 (1) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—The amounts author-
8 ized to be appropriated under section 101 and, sub-
9 ject to section 103, the authorized personnel ceilings
10 as of September 30, 2014, for the conduct of the in-
11 telligence activities of the elements listed in para-
12 graphs (1) through (16) of section 101, are those
13 specified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations
14 for fiscal year 2014 prepared to accompany the bill
15 H.R. ____ of the One Hundred Thirteenth Con-
16 gress.

17 (2) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—The amounts author-
18 ized to be appropriated under section 101 and, sub-
19 ject to section 103, the authorized personnel ceilings
20 as of September 30, 2015, for the conduct of the in-
21 telligence activities of the elements listed in para-
22 graphs (1) through (16) of section 101, are those
23 specified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations
24 for fiscal year 2015 prepared to accompany the bill

1 H.R. _____ of the One Hundred Thirteenth Con-
2 gress.

3 (b) AVAILABILITY OF CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AU-
4 THORIZATIONS.—

5 (1) AVAILABILITY.—The classified Schedules of
6 Authorizations referred to in subsection (a) shall be
7 made available to the Committee on Appropriations
8 of the Senate, the Committee on Appropriations of
9 the House of Representatives, and to the President.

10 (2) DISTRIBUTION BY THE PRESIDENT.—Sub-
11 ject to paragraph (3), the President shall provide for
12 suitable distribution of the classified Schedules of
13 Authorizations, or of appropriate portions of the
14 Schedules, within the executive branch.

15 (3) LIMITS ON DISCLOSURE.—The President
16 shall not publicly disclose the classified Schedules of
17 Authorizations or any portion of such Schedules ex-
18 cept—

19 (A) as provided in section 601(a) of the
20 Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11
21 Commission Act of 2007 (50 U.S.C. 3306(a));

22 (B) to the extent necessary to implement
23 the budget; or

24 (C) as otherwise required by law.

1 **SEC. 103. PERSONNEL CEILING ADJUSTMENTS.**

2 (a) **AUTHORITY FOR INCREASES.**—The Director of
3 National Intelligence may authorize employment of civil-
4 ian personnel in excess of the number authorized for fiscal
5 year 2014 or 2015 by the classified Schedules of Author-
6 izations referred to in section 102(a) if the Director of
7 National Intelligence determines that such action is nec-
8 essary to the performance of important intelligence func-
9 tions, except that the number of personnel employed in
10 excess of the number authorized under such section may
11 not, for any element of the intelligence community, exceed
12 3 percent of the number of civilian personnel authorized
13 under the Schedule for such element during the fiscal year
14 covered by such Schedule.

15 (b) **TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONNEL.**—The Di-
16 rector of National Intelligence shall establish guidelines
17 that govern, for each element of the intelligence commu-
18 nity, the treatment under the personnel levels authorized
19 under section 102(a), including any exemption from such
20 personnel levels, of employment or assignment in—

21 (1) a student program, trainee program, or
22 similar program;

23 (2) a reserve corps or as a reemployed annu-
24 itant; or

25 (3) details, joint duty, or long term, full-time
26 training.

1 (c) NOTICE TO CONGRESSIONAL INTELLIGENCE
 2 COMMITTEES.—The Director of National Intelligence
 3 shall notify the congressional intelligence committees in
 4 writing at least 15 days prior to each exercise of an au-
 5 thority described in subsection (a).

6 **SEC. 104. INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT AC-**
 7 **COUNT.**

8 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

9 (1) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—There is authorized to
 10 be appropriated for the Intelligence Community
 11 Management Account of the Director of National In-
 12 telligence for fiscal year 2014 the sum of
 13 \$528,229,000. Within such amount, funds identified
 14 in the classified Schedule of Authorizations referred
 15 to in section 102(a) for advanced research and de-
 16 velopment shall remain available until September 30,
 17 2015.

18 (2) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—There is authorized to
 19 be appropriated for the Intelligence Community
 20 Management Account of the Director of National In-
 21 telligence for fiscal year 2015 the sum of
 22 **【\$_____】**. Within such amount,
 23 funds identified in the classified Schedule of Author-
 24 izations referred to in section 102(a) for advanced

1 research and development shall remain available
2 until September 30, 2016.

3 (b) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL LEVELS.—The ele-
4 ments within the Intelligence Community Management
5 Account of the Director of National Intelligence are au-
6 thorized 855 positions as of September 30, 2014 and
7 [] positions as of September 30, 2015. Personnel
8 serving in such elements may be permanent employees of
9 the Office of the Director of National Intelligence or per-
10 sonnel detailed from other elements of the United States
11 Government.

12 (c) CLASSIFIED AUTHORIZATIONS.—

13 (1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

14 (A) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—In addition to
15 amounts authorized to be appropriated for the
16 Intelligence Community Management Account
17 by subsection (a), there are authorized to be ap-
18 propriated for the Community Management Ac-
19 count for fiscal year 2014 such additional
20 amounts as are specified in the classified
21 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in sec-
22 tion 102(a). Such additional amounts for ad-
23 vanced research and development shall remain
24 available until September 30, 2015.

1 (B) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—In addition to
2 amounts authorized to be appropriated for the
3 Intelligence Community Management Account
4 by subsection (a), there are authorized to be ap-
5 propriated for the Community Management Ac-
6 count for fiscal year 2014 such additional
7 amounts as are specified in the classified
8 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in sec-
9 tion 102(a). Such additional amounts for ad-
10 vanced research and development shall remain
11 available until September 30, 2016.

12 (2) AUTHORIZATION OF PERSONNEL.—

13 (A) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—In addition to
14 the personnel authorized by subsection (b) for
15 elements of the Intelligence Community Man-
16 agement Account as of September 30, 2014,
17 there are authorized such additional personnel
18 for the Community Management Account as of
19 that date as are specified in the classified
20 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in sec-
21 tion 102(a).

22 (B) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—In addition to
23 the personnel authorized by subsection (b) for
24 elements of the Intelligence Community Man-
25 agement Account as of September 30, 2015,

1 there are authorized such additional personnel
2 for the Community Management Account as of
3 that date as are specified in the classified
4 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in sec-
5 tion 102(a).

6 **TITLE II—CENTRAL INTEL-**
7 **LIGENCE AGENCY RETIRE-**
8 **MENT AND DISABILITY SYS-**
9 **TEM**

10 **SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

11 There is authorized to be appropriated for the Cen-
12 tral Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability
13 Fund—

14 (1) \$514,000,000 for fiscal year 2014; and

15 (2) \$ _____ for fiscal year
16 2015.

17 **TITLE III—GENERAL**
18 **PROVISIONS**

19 **SEC. 301. INCREASE IN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND**
20 **BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY LAW.**

21 Appropriations authorized by this Act for salary, pay,
22 retirement, and other benefits for Federal employees may
23 be increased by such additional or supplemental amounts
24 as may be necessary for increases in such compensation
25 or benefits authorized by law.

1 **SEC. 302. RESTRICTION ON CONDUCT OF INTELLIGENCE**
2 **ACTIVITIES.**

3 The authorization of appropriations by this Act shall
4 not be deemed to constitute authority for the conduct of
5 any intelligence activity which is not otherwise authorized
6 by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.
